The Colonel Noel Percy Adams Trust (Melrose) Society was established in 1974 when the house and gardens were gifted to the Nelson City Council by Colonel Noel Percy Adams. Much more recently Melrose Café was opened to provide an elegant eatery in an historic setting.

The Trust is a registered charitable, not-for-profit incorporated society comprised of volunteers who oversee the governance of the house under the authority of the Nelson City Council. While the exterior and grounds are maintained by the Council, an annually elected Board of Trustees, with the help of Members of the Society and other volunteers, work to preserve, restore and promote this historic house.

The Board's vision for Melrose House is that cultural heritage is preserved and enhanced, contributing to a rich and prosperous future for the Nelson Tasman community and its visitors.
